#### Installation Instructions

### **Site Preparation**

Care should be exercised when preparing for a Juliette Balcony install. In most instance the balcony will need to be lifted into place and should be done with equipment that is rated for heavy lifting using a qualified operator to operate the lifting equipment.

Careful site preparation is required with a thorough understanding of where balcony is to be installed.

Juliette Balcony will need to be attached to solid wall structure with appropriately rated fasteners to meet all applicable code requirements.

Juliette Balconies should not be altered in any way and will have to be installed as ordered.


Lift

Fasteners: Use #14 wood screws or 3/16" diameter masonry screws (16 required).

# Installation

Position balcony into desired location. Use a tape measure and level to ensure that balcony is centered on opening and level. Use drill with drill bit to pre-drill holes for fasteners through mounting plates. Use appropriately rated fasteners to attach balcony to solid wall structure.
